

Android – Outlook app

1. <u>Download Outlook for Android</u> and then open the app. The icon looks like this:



 Tap Get Started if is your first time. Otherwise open the Menu and tap Settings > Add Account > Add Email Account.

3. Enter your full email address, then tap **Continue**.



4. Enter your email account password and tap **Sign In** or **Next**. Note: your sign in screen may look different depending on your email provider.



5. If 2-step verification is enabled, verify yourself using the method you set up (6 digit code, phone call, or Microsoft Authenticator app).
