SPECIAL AND EMERGENCY MEETINGS

Special meetings may from time to time be called by the Chair of the Board or by a majority of the members of the Board. Notice of such meetings shall be posted at least 24 hours before the time of the meeting, and shall be noticed in accordance with Brown Act requirements. No business other than that included in the notice may be transacted or discussed.

Emergency meetings may be called by the Chair of the Board when prompt action is needed because of actual or threatened disruption of public facilities under such circumstances as are permitted by the Brown Act, including work stoppage, crippling disasters, and other activity that severely impairs public health or safety. No closed session shall be conducted during an emergency meeting.

The Superintendent/President shall be responsible to ensure that notice of such meetings is provided to the local news media as required by law.
