SUSPENSION OF DISABLED STUDENTS PROGRAMS AND SERVICES (DSPS) SERVICES

As per Section 56010 of Title 5, Disabled Students Programs and Services (DSPS) services will be suspended when the student fails to comply with either of the following requirements:

- a. Be responsible in his/her use of DSPS services and adherence to written service provision policies outlined in the DSPS handbook; or
- b. Make measurable progress towards the goals established in the DSPS Academic Accommodation Plan and/or when the student is enrolled in a regular college course, meet the academic standards established by the college.
