EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE CLASS REPEATABILITY FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

As per Section 56029 of Title 5, students with verified disabilities may repeat Educational Assistance Classes for a limited number of times under the following conditions:

- When the continuing success of the student in other general and/or Educational Assistance Classes is dependent on additional repetitions of a specific Educational Assistance Class;
- When additional repetitions of an Educational Assistance Class are essential to completing a student's preparation for enrollment into other regular or Educational Assistance Classes;
- When the student has a Disabled Students Programs and Services (DSPS) Academic
 Accommodation Plan which involves a goal other than completion of the Educational
 Assistance Class in question and repetition of the course will further the achievement of that
 goal.
