

Checklist for Reviewing Student Learning Outcomes

- ❑ The outcome states what students can do based on the successful completion of the course.
- ❑ The outcome is measurable. Evidence gathered through an activity, group project, assignment, test, presentation, or paper that indicates to what degree the student can perform the outcome.
- ❑ Each outcome describes one ability the student can demonstrate.
- ❑ The outcome is specifically tied to the course description focusing on the central aspects that are the most meaningful and important.
- ❑ The outcome is appropriate to the level of expertise the student should be at for a career or the associate's level of the discipline.
- ❑ The outcome is specific to the course and could not describe any other course.
